

Zucchini Bread (from Linda Mustain)

3 eggs 2 cups sugar 1 cup oil 2 cups grated raw zucchini 2 cups flour 1/4 tsp. baking powder2 tsp. baking soda3 tsp. cinnamon1 cup walnuts or pecans1 tsp. Salt2 tsp. vanilla

Beat eggs, then add sugar, oil and zucchini.

Mix dry ingredients together and add to the above mixture. Add vanilla and nuts.

Grease and flour 2 loaf pans. Bake in 350 degree oven for 1 hour.

This recipe is from an older **Zion Church Cookbook**

ZUCCHINI CASSEROLE (Lorraine Lofgren)

6 cups sliced zucchini

- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 (6 or 8 oz box) chicken flavored stove top stuffing
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine, melted
- 1/4 cup onions, chopped
- 1 cup shredded carrots

Cook sliced zucchini and onions in boiling salted water for 5 minutes; drain. Combine cream of chicken soup and sour cream. Stir in shredded carrots, then fold in the drained zucchini and onions.

Combine the boxed stuffing mix and butter, spreading half on the bottom of a 9 X 13 inch pan. Spoon the vegetable mixture on top and sprinkle the remaining stuffing on top of that.

Bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes.







To all Members and Friends of Zion:

The decision was made in June 2010 by the church council to keep all of you informed regarding Zion's financial situation. Total revenues for July, 2014 were \$4,658.44 and our expenses were \$6,501.19. This left a *shortfall* for July 2014 in the amount of \$1,842.75. All bills are paid current. Money to cover our shortfall is now coming from the endowment fund. We all need to pray about our financial situation and pray that our monthly revenues increase. We all must have faith that our church will survive and remain open far into the future. We are a vital part of our community here in West Medford. God has placed us here for a reason!!!

An urgent message from Thrivent:
