GOT JOY?

As spring is bursting out all over; the sun is shining, and it's getting warmer, the Church continues to celebrate Easter during a spiritual springtime, a 50-day period that began on Easter Sunday. I want a joy like that, a radiance that lets the world know that Jesus is RISEN FROM THE DEAD. don't you?! We can always choose--thoughts and words of the hope, joy and love of the risen Lord and confess them and feel better and do better and have an impact on others! Jesus is "The light of the world; they who follow me will not be in darkness but will have the light of life" (John 8:12). We can have **JOY**, light, love, encouragement, energy through the Holy Spirit just as surely as the days are becoming longer, brighter, warmer as spring shares God's loveliness in all creation.

This Easter season and springtime, "MAY THE LORD BLESS AND PROTECT YOU; MAY THE LORD'S FACE RADIATE WITH JOY BECAUSE OF YOU; MAY HE BE GRACIOUS TO YOU, SHOW YOU HIS FAVOR AND GIVE YOU HIS PEACE" (Numbers 6:24--26).
