

November and December Activities

Members and Friends of Zion,

In the September/October issue of The Focus we attempted to bring you up to date on the damage done to the Sanctuary and other areas of the Church in the July 5th fire caused by arsonists. In this issue, we have happier things to report regarding the ongoing restoration of Zion's Sanctuary.

We are – finally— entering the home stretch of the restoration process! The latest word from our General Contractor, Claudio Alvarez Construction, is that they (at present, anyway) anticipate the finish date to be approximately the middle of November. As of this writing, the stucco on the outside wall which was damaged has been replaced, most of the painting (inside and out) is finished, the roof has been replaced on the Sanctuary as well as the adjacent house on Zion property, the carpet waits in local storage to be installed at the proper time, the new cross has been built and is just waiting to be put in place outside the Sanctuary at the right moment in time, the pews have been cleaned of smoke and are just being held in storage until the new carpet has been put in. Hymnals, Bibles, and Lutheran Books of Worship which were damaged have been, or are being, replaced. The large painting of Jesus which hangs at the back of the Altar is soon to be cleaned and restored to pre-fire condition, and the wonderful large organ sitting at the rear of the Sanctuary cannot be restored until everything else (all the messy stuff) in the Sanctuary has been completed. In short, it has been a long involved process, but it is soon –thankfully - to be behind us and we will be able to move on to happier things.

There is to be a rededication of Zion's Sanctuary, most likely in early December, as it will take time to publicize the event and send out invitations to all who have been so generous in their support of Zion during this recovery period following the fire. We will be sending out information and details, and perhaps an invitation to 'lend a hand' as the planning unfolds.

Sunday, November 2nd—November 16th


The Zion Youth and Sunday School Children will be conducting a food drive to help fill Thanksgiving food baskets for the hungry.


